DBB Architecture, P.C. is a New York based firm providing architecture, interior design and life safety consulting services for diverse building types.

Established in 2001, the firm is incorporated in the State of New York. DBB Architecture, P.C. is a minority-owned business enterprise (MBE), and is certified by several local and State agencies. The firm is currently licensed to practice in 5 regional States: New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania and Maryland.

DBB Architecture, P.C.'s clientele includes a wide selection of entities in public and private sectors, including Federal, State and local government agencies, not-for-profit organizations and private developers. With offices in White Plains, Tarrytown, and Valley Stream, the firm is strategically positioned to service clients throughout the northeastern US region.

DBB Architecture, P.C. has contributed to the New York City landscape through a variety of avenues, with special emphasis on the enhancement of educational and healthcare facilities in the region. The firm has been especially committed to development of early child development centers in underserved communities. Since its formation, DBB Architecture, P.C. has collaborated with the Administration for Children's Services and the US Office of Head Start to upgrade multiple non-code compliant learning environments, expand existing facilities, and create new centers throughout the New York metropolitan area. These efforts have also included the implementation of flood

mitigation, sustainability and resiliency strategies for such facilities. DBB Architecture, P.C. is also engaged with local non-profit organizations including the Catholic Diocese regional services, to pursue value-added adaptive reuse of shuttered educational facilities in the region.

DBB Architecture, P.C. is led by **Dayo Babalola**, supported by a team of talented and experienced architects and engineering consultants. DBB has also teamed up with other consultants to execute multiple large-scale projects in New York City.



DBB Architecture, P.C. served as Associate Architects for the design of the Public Safety Answering Center II for the New York City Department of Design and Construction (DDC), located in the Bronx borough. The 540,000 square feet PSAC II



accommodates emergency dispatch services for the New York Police Department (NYPD), the Fire Department of New York (FDNY), along with the Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications (DOITT). DBB Architecture, P.C. assisted the PSAC II design team with compliance of egress, life safety and code compliance issues.

DBB Architecture, P.C. is currently working alongside other laboratory planning consultants on the design and development of a new Public Health Laboratory for New York City. The 230,000 square foot Biosafety Level 3 facility will be constructed near the Harlem Hospital, and is expected to be completed at the end of 2023. In the Town of Harrison, Westchester County NY, the firm is engaged in the development and documentation of a new clinical research laboratory for a firm specializing in DNA health testing services. The DNA laboratory will complete construction in August 2020.

DBB Architecture PC provided support architectural services to the prime design architects for the JFK Delta Terminal 4 Headhouse Project in 2011 and served as the Associate Architects for the LaGuardia Airport Central Terminal Building master plan Design Phase 1 in late 2012.

DBB has collaborated with local communities in efforts to revitalize environments in disrepair, regenerating viable social and economic value. DBB has been working with some religious groups to develop new facilities for worship and outreach programs in multiple New York boroughs. DBB

Architecture PC and The Solomon Foundation recently completed construction of a new 500 seat worship facility for the Kings Church of Christ, in the East New York, Brooklyn.

DBB Architecture PC has been very active in development activity in the West 125th Street retail corridor. For two decades, the firm has worked on multiple commercial store projects with local developers and retailers in Harlem, New York. The firm's Principal Architect is the Architect-of-Record for Harlem's largest big-box retail entertainment center, Harlem USA.

DBB provides building safety systems consulting services, among other post-occupancy consultant services to local property management companies and developers.
